HI THERE!


This tutorial is a quick and easy way to make your own Challah Cover. It makes the perfect wedding gift, or keep it for yourself to help make all your Shabbat celebrations beautiful and special. The <u>illustrated fabric panel shown in this tutorial</u> can be purchased in my <u>Spoonflower Shop</u> for about \$11.00 (not including tax and shipping). HOW TO FIND ME ON SPOONFLOWER

If for some reason the link to this panel doesn't work, here's how to find it on Spoonflower...

- 1. Go to www.spoonflower.com
- 2. In search bar at top of page, enter: vicky_katzman (other Vickys might come up if you scroll down, but I only have this one shop "vicky_katzman".)

3. Click on this challah cover panel (there are two different listings for this design, one with guidelines and one without - select the one with guidelines - see blue arrow below) and it will bring you straight to it. (Alternatively, under the fabric title "Shabbat Shalom Challah Cover", click on the grayed out "vicky_katzman" and it will bring you to my shop where you'll see all my challah cover designs!)

HOW TO PURCHASE THE PANEL


1. Once you're on the panel listing, settings should be as follows:

FABRIC: Petal Signature Cotton*

SIZE: Fat Quarter 21"x18"


QUANTITY: 1 (or however many separate panels you want)

2. Now you're good to checkout!



* If you press on the pop-up menu under "FABRIC", you can view all the fabrics that Spoonflower has available. For each type of fabric, they list the width, and the size of the "Fat Quarter" is dependent on that width. This challah cover panel is designed to fit a 21"x18" fat quarter with minimum waste. To eliminate waste, choose any fabric that's 42" wide.

42" wide fabrics on offer (as of September 2023) are shown here.



ONCE THE FABRIC ARRIVES



1. Wash and iron the fabric panel.



2. Find a piece of plain white cotton fabric or anything you'd like to use as the underside of your challah cover. Pin right sides together and sew along dotted line. Leave a small opening about 5" wide.

3. Trim excess fabric .25" away from seam.





4. Snip corners at an angle to reduce bulk.

5. Turn right side out. Use something long and thin (like the eraser side of a pencil) to push out the corners.



6. To close opening, tuck ends of fabric under .25" and pin. Hand sew closed.



7. Optional: for an extra special touch, use silver metallic thread to outline illustrations and along the edges of the border.

Your challah cover is now complete
- I hope you use your handmade
creation for many years to come!
